You can give eyesight to the poor & needy children of rural Rajasthan (India)

Villages of Churu district in Rajasthan (Indian) are remote and underprivileged. The villagers here are extremely poor and having very low health status. There are few medical facilities in this area, the presence of doctors and quality of services is always a great concern.

Problems related to eyesight and cataract has high prevalence rate in this area. Due to the



extreme poverty and lack of medical facilities peoples prefer to lead a life of blindness due to cataract and children often dropout from school. Boruka Charitable Trust's Chhogmal Boruka Hospital takes lots of efforts to provide them modern and quality eye care services. The hospital has eye surgeon and well trained and qualified staff for eye screening of school going children. BCT conducts eye screening among government school children within far off rural areas in different parts of the state. We now conduct monthly eye screening in first week of each month to

facilitate the need of children. All the required equipments, medicines, spectacles etc are given free to the needy children. The team of volunteers & BCT workers put their efforts together in pre and post care of children. BCT has built a fully equipped, modern and sterile operation theatre in its health center at Borugram.

For eye screening of school children and providing them power spectacles it will cost Rs.150/- (Rupees one hundred fifty only) **or \$ 3.** per children to us.
